



« Peru National Energy Plan 2014-2025 and its contribution against Climate Change »

This conference will present the Peruvian “*Plan Energetico Nacional 2014-2025*” and address the key issues in the country’s energy sector.

Mr Eleodoro MAYORGA, former Minister of Energy and Mines of Peru (2014-2015) will discuss the most recent developments with regards to energy policy in Peru and the role of this country, that hosted the last UN Climate Conference (CoP20) in Lima last year, in reaching a successful global climate agreement in Paris in 2015.

Mr Eleodoro MAYORGA, an IFP School Alumni (ECO’75), was Minister of Energy and Mines of Peru between February 2014 and February 2015 and was one leader of the Peruvian delegation during the last UN Climate conference held in Lima in December 2014.

Mr MAYORGA began his career in Petroperù, Peru’s National oil company. He then joined The World Bank and worked for 18 years as a Senior Energy Economist. In 2009, he returned to Peru and joined Laub & Quijandría Consultores y Abogados, where he worked for 4 years as an energy consultant.
